Monday, August 15th from 4:00-6:00 is our Meet the Teacher Ice Cream Social event hosted by the PTA. If you ordered supplies from the school sale, they will be delivered to the classroom labeled with your child's name. After you visit your child's classroom, stop by the multipurpose room to reconnect with your friends and pick up an ice cream treat! <u>DROP OFF AND PICK UP INFORMATION:</u> Please review the enclosed traffic pattern for arrival and dismissal. Please follow these directions to help our arrival and dismissal process run smoothly.

IMPORTANT KINDERGARTEN INFORMATION:

This year, all Worthington Schools will follow a staggered Kindergarten start. We will "phase in" the kindergarteners on the 17th and 18th. Half of the kindergarten classes will come on Wednesday the 17th, the other half will come on Thursday the 18th and then they will all attend together on Friday the 19th. Your child's assigned phase-in day will be shared when teacher assignments are sent out on August 12th.

GENERAL P.M. KINDERGARTEN INFORMATION

P.M. Kindergarteners can be dropped off starting at 11:20. Parents must park their cars and walk students up to the building. Parents need to be mindful of traffic coming in and out of the school when they park. Parents may NOT pull into the no parking zone in front of the school to drop students off or park to walk them into the building. There will be a staff member to line students up in front of the building to walk them in for the start of class at 11:30. Students that come after that time will need to be signed in at the office by an adult. Students who are bus riders or who are transported by a daycare will be monitored by a staff member when they are dropped off and will be escorted out to their transportation at the end of the day.

*Kindergarten Parents may walk their student to class on the first day but moving forward, please plan on saying goodbye at the front door for half day kindergarten and the corner for all day kindergarten after the first day. We also find that short goodbyes make the transition into school much easier.

BUILDING VISITS AND STUDENT SIGN IN AND SIGN OUT:

Worthington Schools will be using the online SchoolSafeID electronic sign in / sign out visitor system again this school year. Every visitor and volunteer that enters the building will be asked to check in using this system. This is also how we track student sign in and sign outs. The first time you sign in, you will need your driver's license or state issued ID. You can download a pass on any smartphone and use the pass to check in on subsequent visits. Thank you for your cooperation with this. The safety of our students is very important to us.

BIRTHDAY CELEBRATIONS:

Worthington Schools asks that we do not celebrate student birthdays with food in the classroom. So, as a reminder, please do not send in cookies, cupcakes, candy or other food items with your child to share with classmates. If you would like to send in something for your child to share with their classmates on their birthday, please consider sending stickers, pencils, trinkets, etc. or plan a special activity such as reading a book or playing a game.

Snacks will be served throughout the year during scheduled celebrations. Families will always be informed when food will be brought into classrooms so that alternate plans can be made for students with dietary restrictions.


CURRICULUM NIGHT:

Dear Colonial Hills Families:

Due to some feedback from families regarding safety and observations made by myself and other staff, I would like to try something different with our drop off this year. Obviously, my primary goal is to always make sure student safety is the priority while hopefully making the morning routine more efficient and less chaotic. Here are the important points to note:

- School hours this year are 7:40-2:20.
 - Bus drop off will be at 7:30
 - Car drop off and walker arrival will be at 7:30
- Greenwich will be closed to car traffic at drop off and dismissal (daycare vans only).
- Drop off traffic will flow one way following the arrows.
- Parents should pull up to the curb along the north side of Colonial, stopping only long
 enough for students to get out of the car and then proceed forward. Parents should not
 park on Colonial and get out of the car with students. Traffic should flow west on Colonial,
 parents will pull up to the curb and students should exit the car only on the curb side.
- When pulling up for drop off, students need to be ready to exit the car (curb side only).
 They should have their backpack in hand and be ready to go!
- If you would like to park your car and walk your student up to the intersection to drop them off, you can park on Greenwich south of Park Blvd.
- There will be a staff member on duty in the morning and after school at the top of the ravine at South Field for families who would like to use that area for drop off and pick up (I strongly encourage this as it helps reduce congestion at the Colonial/Greenwich intersection).
- We will continue to ask parents who walk students to school to say goodbye at the corner/intersection of Colonial and Greenwich.
- For now, dismissal procedures will remain the same as previous years (with the exception Greenwich being closed). Walkers and car riders will be walked out at 2:20.

The district is now utilizing the School Safe ID system. This new system offers a fast, simple way to electronically register and review individuals who visit our schools and who need to sign students out of school. Visitors and Volunteers, including parents/guardians needing to sign a student out, will be required to provide a Driver's License or other state-issued identification, which will be scanned through the School Safe ID visitor management system. You will then have the option to download a Digital Pass on your phone.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO BRING YOUR LICENSE/STATE ID INTO THE BUILDING WITH YOU OR YOUR PHONE (if you already have your Digital Pass) IN ORDER TO SIGN A STUDENT OUT OR VISIT/VOLUNTEER.

Attendance Reporting and Dismissal Changes

If your child needs to miss a day of school, or will be late getting to school, please call the office at 614-450-5400. Our office line has 24 hour voicemail and messages can be left anytime the office is closed. Please call absences in to the office rather than emailing classroom teachers when possible.

Per district policy, if we have not heard from a parent for attendance reporting, our office staff will make contact with parents by email or phone to verify the student's absence.

Attendance, continued

Guidelines-When to Keep Your Child Home from School

The protocol for management of communicable disease in Worthington City Schools is based upon the Ohio Department of Health's guidelines and recommendations. Your child is too ill to go to school if any of the following symptoms are present:

- Temperature of 100 F or above by mouth (Student must stay home until fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication. In most cases this means the student will miss the following school day. Please understand fevers can reoccur within a 24 hour time period and this policy is in the best interest of all students.)
- Vomiting or diarrhea within the past 24 hours (Student must stay home for 24 hours to ensure these symptoms are gone before returning to school.) □ Shortness of breath or increased wheezing during normal activity
- Has a cough that interrupts normal activity
- Pain from an earache, headache, sore throat or recent injury
- Has yellow or green drainage from nose or eye(s)
- Rash over body or localized to one area of the body (A student who shows signs of a communicable disease exhibiting as a rash may return to school once the rash is gone or a doctor's note is presented stating the student may return to school.)
- Fatigue that requires bed rest (common with flu-like symptoms)
- Signs of conjunctivitis such as red, crusty or swollen eyes (Student may return once symptoms have been treated and are gone or a doctor's note is presented stating the student may return to school.)

If your child is ill, please do not send them to school to be checked by the school nurse. Such exposure may be harmful to the child as well as to the children with whom they come in contact.

Daily Dismissal Form & Dismissal Changes

Please complete the Daily Dismissal Plan Google form sent via email as early as possible. This helps ensure our dismissal plans for each student is accurate.

After school has started, if you need to make changes to your child's dismissal plan, please contact the office at 614-450-5400 by 2 p.m. PLEASE DO NOT EMAIL DISMISSAL CHANGES TO STAFF MEMBERS. This is to make sure no changes are missed in email. Please keep changes to emergency situations only as frequent changes often confuse children and can possibly result in unsafe situations.

2022-2023 SCHOOL INSTRUCTIONAL FEES

The Worthington School district asks parents to contribute a little more than other residents for the cost of educating their children. There are additional costs for reading and math materials and other consumable supplies that are used in areas such as art, math, science and handwriting. The fees vary by grade level as the types of materials are different.

The money collected for these materials will be deposited in a school supplies fund that serves your school. These funds will enable us to provide your child's teacher with materials the classroom.

The fee schedule for the 2022-2023 school year is:

Kindergarten = \$24

Grades 1, 2 & 3 = \$42




