C-3-c Continued Enrollment of Seniors Moving Out of District

Recommended motion: "...to approve the continued enrollment of <u>Zachary Weingartner</u>, a senior, whose legal guardian has moved from the Worthington School District, and to approve the continued enrollment of <u>Luanda Montilla Soto</u>, a senior, whose legal guardians have moved from the Worthington School District."

Zachary and Luanda are currently enrolled at Thomas Worthington High School. His parent and her parents moved out of the Worthington School District. Both Zachary and Luanda would like to complete their senior year in Worthington Schools, and graduate with the class of 2016.

According to the Ohio Revised Code, 3313.64(F), "Any child under the age of twenty-two whose parent has moved out of the school district after commencement of classes in the child's senior year of high school is entitled, subject of the approval of the district board, to attend school in the district in which the child attended at the time of the parental move for the remainder of the school year and for one additional semester or equivalent term." Furthermore, BOE policy states that the student must have attended at least four semesters in Worthington Schools and have achieved at least junior status. These students meet these requirements.

This is the second and third such request this school year.

C-3-d Authorization to Advertise Capital Improvement Packages at Various District Facilities

Recommended motion: "...to authorize the treasurer to advertise for bids in accordance with Sections 3313.46 and 153-01 of the Ohio Revised Code for the following 2012 bond issue projects:

These packages contain multiple projects. Roofing projects were identified in the 2012 Bond Issue and Wilson Hill flooring is a new project. All have been assembled to take advantages in economies of scale provided through shared design services and increased bidding interest generated from larger projects. Specific projects associated with each package will be posted on the district website prior to advertisement.

Architectural/engineering design, specifications, prints and bidding documents for these improvement projects are being finalized in preparation for advertisements for the required bidding process. Recommended contracts for award will be presented to the Worthington

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Board of Education during the months of February or March. All of these projects are scheduled for completion by the start of the 2016/2017 school year. Public bidding schedule and projects specific to each bid package will be available on the district website.
