### **B-1-a Visitor Comments**

Ms. Shawna Moraille of Riley Avenue founded the group Protect Worthington. She urged the Board to continue the universal masking beyond March 14<sup>th</sup>.

Ms. Beth Besecker also would like the mask mandate continued. She said her children have commented about anxiety and stress due to kids not wearing masks correctly.

Ms. Jessica Haglund of Hartford Street said she is the founder of a grass-roots group that advocates for special education students. She is in favor of continued mask mandates.

Ms. Christine Stoner of Crandall Drive urged the Board to recognize immunocompromised folks and keep the mask mandate in place until the end of the school year.

The administrative heads of the schools understand that failure to discharge the duty of primary enforcement may result in fines, removal from tournaments, suspension from membership and/or other such penalties as prescribed in Bylaw 11."
