We expect speakers to share comments in a civil and respectful manner. We also prefer grievances about a particular employee to not be shared during a public session, however, community members who wish to share personnel concerns may contact the Superintendent to do so at thousers@wscloud.org.

The presiding officer may:

- 1. Prohibit public comments that are frivolous, repetitive and/or harassing.
- 2. Interrupt, warn or terminate a participant's statement when the statement is too lengthy, abusive, off-topic, obscene or irrelevant.
- 3. Request any individual to leave the meeting when that person does not observe reasonable decorum or is disruptive to the conduct of the meeting.
- 4. Request the assistance of law enforcement officers in the removal of a disorderly person when that person's conduct interferes with the orderly progress of the meeting.
- 5. Call for a recess or an adjournment to another time when the lack of public decorum so interferes with the orderly conduct of the meeting as to warrant such action.

Board members may ask questions of the speaker for information or clarification and may or may not make comments in response to a speaker's remarks. No board member has the power or authority to act for the board; therefore, no response from an individual board member should be interpreted as an official action.
