WHEREAS, section 3313.90 of the Ohio Revised Code stipulates that local school districts may adopt a resolution that specifies the district's intent to not provide career-technical education to students enrolled in grades seven and eight for a particular school year:

WHEREAS, Section 3313.90 further provides that if any district submits that resolution to the Ohio Department of Education, the department shall waive the requirement for that district to provide career-technical education to students enrolled in grades seven and eight for that particular school year.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Worthington School District Board of Education hereby waives the requirement to provide career-technical education in grades seven and eight for the 2020-2021 school year as allowed by section 3313.90."

D-1-a Continued Enrollment of Senior Moving Out of District

Recommended motion: "...to approve the continued enrollment of Maeve Pack Maeve is currently enrolled at Worthington Kilbourne High School. Because her family moved out of the Worthington School District, she would like to complete her senior year in Worthington Schools, and graduate with the class of 2021.

According to the Ohio Revised Code, 3313.64(F), "Any child under the age of twenty-two whose parent has moved out of the school district after commencement of classes in the child's senior year of high school is entitled, subject to the approval of the district board, to attend school in the district in which the child attended at the time of the parental move for the remainder of the school year and for one additional semester or equivalent term." Furthermore, BOE policy states that the student must have attended at least four semesters in Worthington Schools and have achieved at least junior status. This student meets these requirements.

This is the 4th such request this school year.
