No board member has the power or authority to act for the board; therefore, no response from an individual board member should be interpreted as an official action.

Requests for information about any subject should be made in writing to the board president or superintendent. Requests for information at the board meeting will be referred to the superintendent for review and report to the board.

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NOW THEREFORE BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Worthington Board of Education shall for the foreseeable future, expand the means by which public comment is incorporated into Board meetings by accepting public comment at the beginning and end of Board meetings."
