B-1-a Visitor Comments

B-1-b High School Course Proposal and High School Course Name Change

Jennifer Wene, Chief Academic Officer, will present recommended revisions to the high school curricula for the 2016-2017 school year to include a new course and a course name change. A brief description is as follows:

High School Course Proposal

Global Scholars I is a course that teaches global fluency in cross-curricular areas through inquiry-based practices. The course is designed to acknowledge students who demonstrate global competencies above and beyond the curriculum requirements. Students will create a digital portfolio of these competencies. The four categories of competencies that will be assessed are: investigating the world, recognizing perspectives, communicating ideas, and taking action. The credit is .5, and the course uses a Blended Learning format.

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High School Course Name Change

Change IB History to IB History / Advanced Studies in History I: Conflict and Conflict Resolution, in order to allow students not interested in the IB History Exam to participate in the full curriculum and receive credit.

C-3-c Continued Enrollment of Senior Moving out of District

Recommended motion: "...to approve the continued enrollment of Madison Middleton, whose legal guardian has moved from the Worthington School District."

Madison is currently enrolled at Worthington Kilbourne High School. Because her family moved out of the Worthington School District, she would like to complete her senior year in Worthington Schools, and graduate with the class of 2017.

According to the Ohio Revised Code, 3313.64(F), "Any child under the age of twenty-two whose parent has moved out of the school district after commencement of classes in the child's senior year of high school is entitled, subject to the approval of the district board, to attend school in the district in which the child attended at the time of the parental move for the remainder of the school year and for one additional semester or equivalent term." Furthermore, BOE policy states that the student must have attended at least four semesters in Worthington Schools and have achieved at least junior status. This student meets these requirements.

This is the sixth such request this school year.
