B-1-a Visitor Comments

B-1-b High School Course Proposal and High School Course Name Change

Jennifer Wene, Chief Academic Officer, presented recommended revisions to the high school curricula for the 2016-2017 school year to include a new course and a course name change. A brief description is as follows:

High School Course Proposal

Global Scholars I is a course that teaches global fluency in cross-curricular areas through inquiry-based practices. The course is designed to acknowledge students who demonstrate global competencies above and beyond the curriculum requirements. Students will create a digital portfolio of these competencies. The four categories of competencies that will be assessed are: investigating the world, recognizing

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perspectives, communicating ideas, and taking action. The credit is .5, and the course uses a Blended Learning format.

High School Course Name Change

Change IB History to IB History / Advanced Studies in History I: Conflict and Conflict Resolution, in order to allow students not interested in the IB History Exam to participate in the full curriculum and receive credit.

B-1-c Presentation on Federal Funding and Worthington Schools

Assistant Treasurer T.J. Cusick presented an overview of how federal funding affects Worthington Schools.

B-1-d Board/Committee Reports, Announcements, and Updates

Mrs. Keegan, Mrs. Best, and Mr. Shim all wished Mr. Schare a happy birthday.

Mr. Schare thanked the board for their well wishes and then updated the board on school legislation. Explaining that the Ohio House and Senate will enter its lame-duck session today and tomorrow, Mr. Schare said that the Senate Education Committee is meeting to discuss the following bills: Senate Bill 3, an anti-regulatory bill introduced last April 2015, a truancy bill, a bill to mandate course work in personal financial literacy, and a bill for medicaid and schools. Mr. Schare added that there is also a financial bill involving CAUV calculations, explaining that this has to do with an increase in valuation when a developer buys a property. Mr. Schare stated that all these bills could pass tomorrow or die in the lame-duck session and there is nothing we can do but have our representatives on speed dial.
