## SECOND AGREEMENT ADDENDUM

WHEREAS, the WORTHINGTON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION, ("Worthington") and the DELAWARE AREA CAREER CENTER BOARD OF EDUCATION, ("DACC") (collectively, the "Parties") entered into an Agreement in October 25, 2004 to establish a career and technical (vocational) education program (the "Agreement"). Among other things, the Agreement required Worthington to pay DACC a "Service Charge" in accordance with the procedure set out therein. The Agreement also provided that it would continue in force and effect through the 2009-2010 school year. At that time, the Agreement renewed automatically for successive five year periods and will continue to do so unless either party gives written notice to the other party's Superintendent, 18 months prior to the year in which the Agreement expires, of the party's intent to terminate or modify the contract terms; and

WHEREAS, on February 23, 2009, the Parties entered into the First Agreement Addendum (the "First Addendum") to modify the definition and formula for determining the "Service Charge," as referenced within the Agreement and detailed on Exhibit A of the Agreement. The First Addendum also declared that Exhibit A, as originally attached to the Agreement, null and void; and

WHEREAS, due to various changes that have occurred during the intervening years, including changes to school funding in Ohio that have led to variations in the transactions between the Parties regarding the amount of the Service Charge over time;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants, undertakings, and other consideration set forth in this Second Addendum, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement and First Addendum to modify the definition and formula for determining the Service Charge as follows:

- 1. The Parties agree that the Service Charge will be equal to the total foundation funding the Ohio Department of Education pays on Worthington's behalf to DACC for Worthington students enrolled in DACC, provided, however, that nothing contained in this Second Addendum shall be read to eliminate the Five Percent Guarantee set forth in the Agreement. Should the five percent guarantee be enacted, the service charge per student will equal the "average statewide base cost per student" per the funding formula.
- 2. DACC will pay Worthington \$30,090 each year for Career Technical programming.
