WHEREAS, the School District acknowledges that neither the School District nor the Commission have control over conditions which are hidden or otherwise unknown at the conclusion of the assessment report and amended master facility plan; and

WHEREAS, the School District desires to proceed with the amended scope of the project and amended Master Facility Plan as indicated below:

## SCOPE OF THE PROJECT:

Build three new elementary schools to house grades K thru 5; renovate Sutter Park Elementary School to house grades PK thru 5 and Bluffsview, Granby, Liberty, Slate Hill, Wilson Hill, Worthington Hills & Worthington Park elementary schools to house grades K thru 5; renovations/additions to Kilbourne & McCord middle schools and Phoenix Middle School & Worthington Academy to house grades 6 thru 8; renovations/addition/partial demolition to Worthingway Middle School to house grades 6 thru 8 and Thomas Worthington High School to house grades 9 thru 12 & Career Tech; renovations/addition to Worthington Kilbourne High School to house grades 9 thru 12 & Career Tech (off-site); allowance to abate and demolish Brookside, Colonial Hills, Evening Street and Worthington Estates elementary schools (no action required at Linworth Alternative School as this facility will be utilized for other than K thru 12 instruction).
