We recognize the importance of auditing class sizes and staffing levels on a regular basis to ensure an appropriate balance exists between our buildings and to provide support in areas/buildings that have a higher academic need. As the data shows, the middle schools are fairly similar across the board when looking at class size. The area we believe assistance could be provided is in the area of math/science at Worthingway.

Consideration: Move a 1.0 math/science certified staff member from McCord to Worthingway.

- .6 of their schedule would be math: It would provide an "extra scoop" for our at-risk math students affording them the opportunity to take two math classes during the day.
- .4 of their schedule would be science: It would offset class sizes at both the 7th and 8th grade levels.
