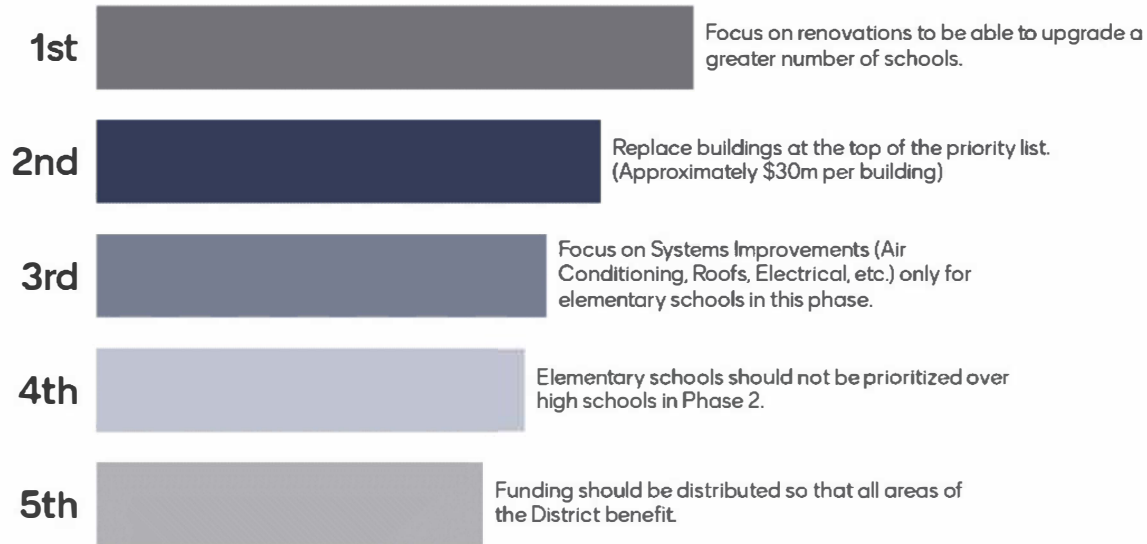
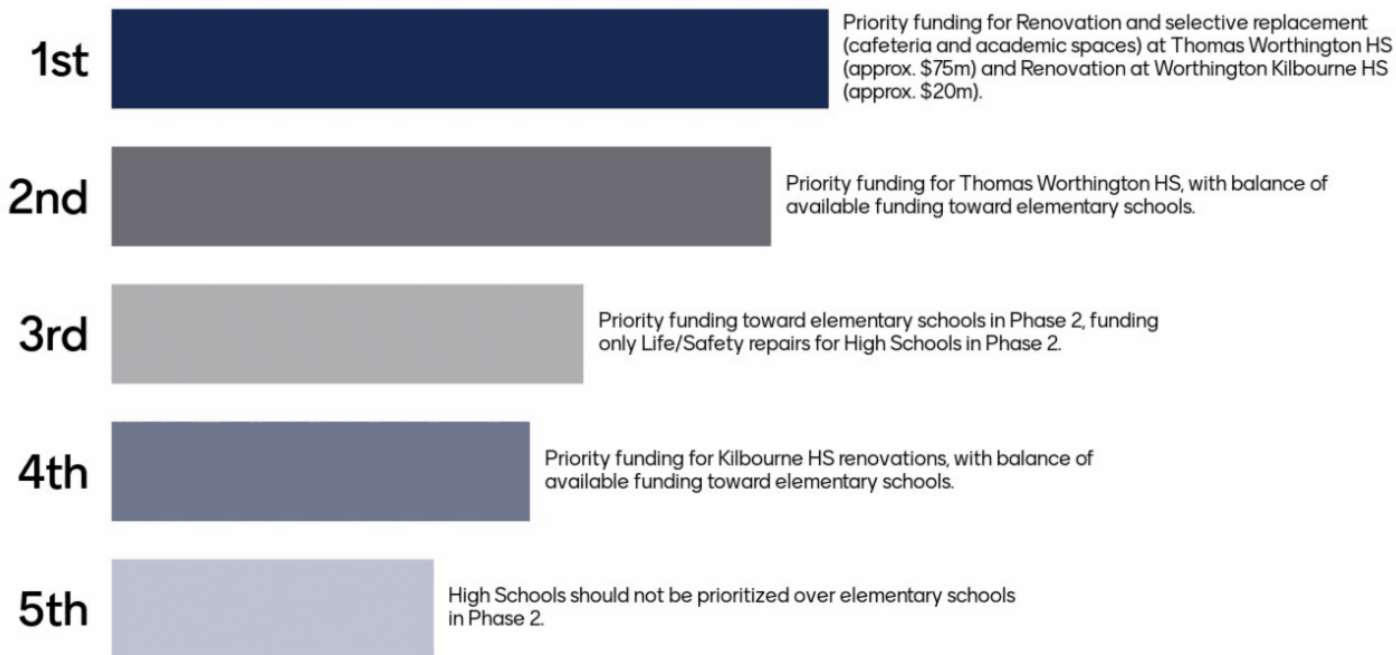


If Elementary Schools are to be part of Phase 2 of the Capital Plan, what should be the focus of improvements? Please rank highest (1) to lowest (5).



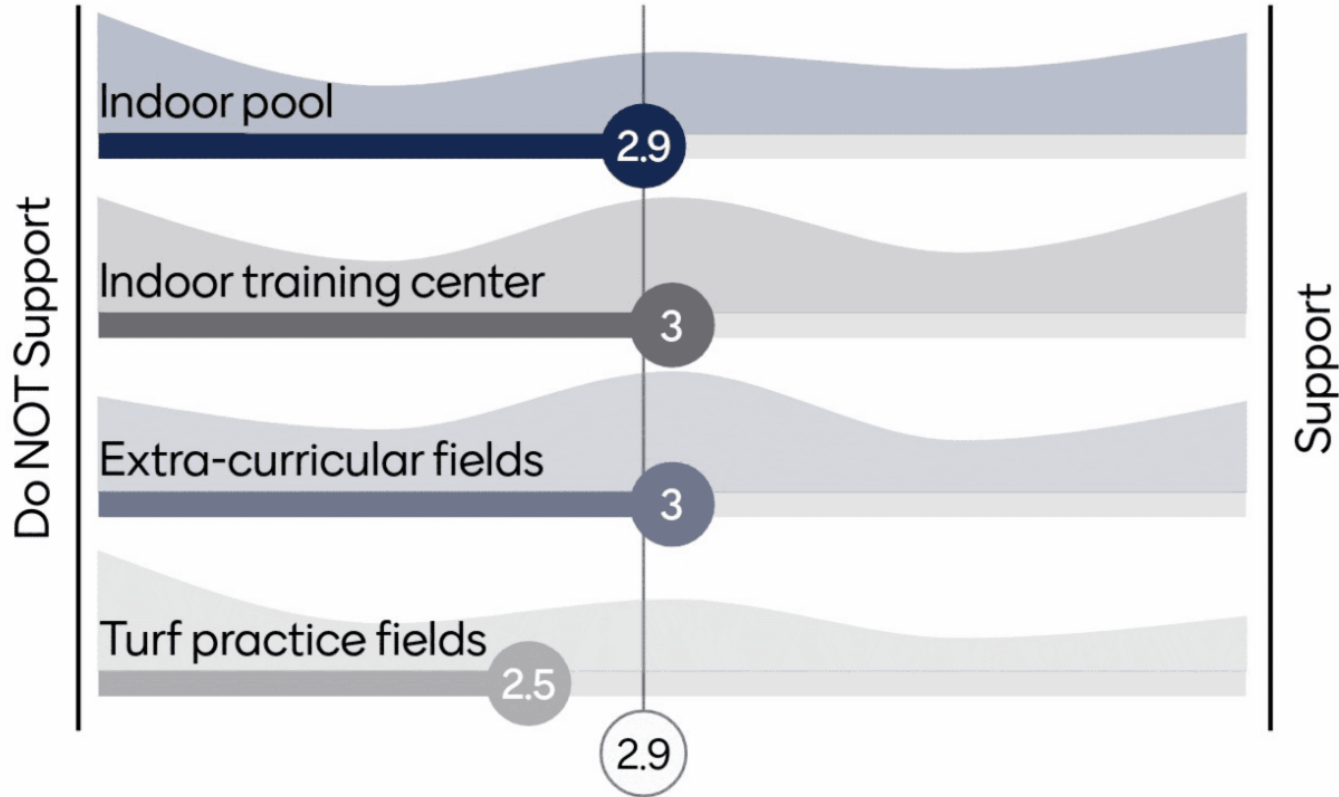
If High Schools are to be part of Phase 2 of the Capital Plan, what should be the focus of improvements? Please rank highest (1) to lowest (5).



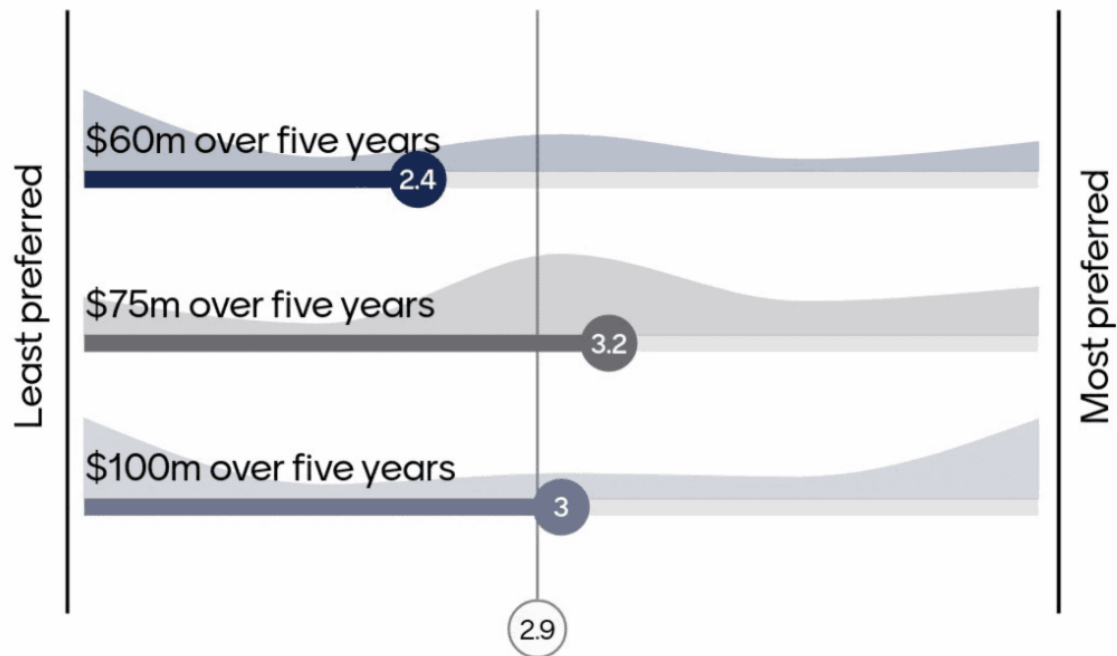
Please rate your level of support for how to address support facilities such as the WEC, Prof. Dev., Maintenance, Warehouse, and Transportation.

I believe It would be beneficial the last option provided would be best, because it offers more buildings being renovated or replaced.

All public funds should be put towards education. Pools, Football Fields, Indoor Tracks etc should be funded by athletic boosters or a bond issue completely separate from general education and building funds.

High Schools now! Elementary Schools over time. Equity for the community. Most bang for our buck!

While we note equity in the education our kids are getting from a curriculum perspective, there is much disparity between the buildings and the space/light/access/etc. they offer. As we look to prioritizing I hope we acknowledge this impact too.

Do not relocate Colonial Hills Elementary School. The current location is an asset to the community. Preservation of South Field is a TOP priority.

I don't feel that I have enough information to answer if high schools or elementary schools should be prioritized. I am not aware of which have the bigger needs. Also don't know enough about financing implications on prioritizing new builds vs reno

Thomas Worthington needs to be prioritized in Phase 2. The enrollment will continue to stay high and the building does not have the space for its enrollment nor quality facilities.

I would like to see Brookside replaced.

If the pool isn't funded, will it close permanently? I don't want to lose the pool.

I support the schools and have 2 children attending, but real estate taxes are getting very high. Find ways to increase industry/business in Worthington, to give homeowners relief.

I don't support high school renovations at this time because it forces our middle schoolers to have so many years in a row with disruptions to their buildings and schedules. Let the middle school changes settle for a bit; focus on elementary schools.

Will not support any funding requests on Election Day that include the community enhancements (e.g., pool, turf fields). Focus on the schools then the district support buildings. Do not try to solve everything.

You should prioritize Thomas Worthington replacement. The balance of funds should be used to fix the capacity issues that are still left at the elementary level. Your phase 1 solution did not work as we still have modulars at multiple elementaries.

No levy should be presented. Figure out the facilities updates with the current funds. No money spent on pools that impact select affluent individuals and not the broader student population

It is time to address the entirety of TWHS and surrounding grounds...field house, baseball updates, maintenance facilities, pool. It will just keep getting more expensive. Nice things cost money, so it is important to optimize our tax dollars.

Would be nice if the WEC and other maintenance facilities need upgraded to do it on site at the schools. To have a more interactive administration with staff and students. Pool is definitely a must that Worthington is missing and preschool.

Worthington Schools has plenty of money with the passing of the last two levies. Do not ask residents to support any additional levies.

Looking good so far

TWHS is an embarrassment of facilities in the OCC, the only exception is the football field which has had 2 new turfs installed. Baseball and softball fields look like poorly funded community fields. The inside of TWHS is also poor.

The School Board's actions over the past year have hurt any chances for this to pass. The divisiveness of certain members has left an embittered community reluctant to support more spending if the safety of our kids is not a priority.

Our children deserve the best. We need to expand our buildings so that we are not having overcrowding that causes our children's education to suffer.

Will the music wing be included in a reno/replace option for TWHS? The band program in particular NEEDS more space!

Whatever you do, do not redistrict!

Thank you for preserving the historical integrity of KMS. History and community location are very important especially with schools like Colonial Hills Elementary.

I hope the high schools, Thomas in particular, will be the focus of Phase 2 as discussed when Phase 1 began.

Do NOT include changing boundary lines as part of Phase 2 of the Facilities Master Plan. If the 23 North Corridor is redistricted, we will lobby all the neighborhoods impacted to vote "NO" for the next operating levy and bond.

Replacing / relocating CHES would change the nature of the school and the community it serves. It's location may not be the most ideal (for busses, etc), but the connection to nature and overall walkability is a rare asset. I support reno only.

Reduce scope to maximum extent possible and focus on achieving minimum improvements necessary at lowest cost.

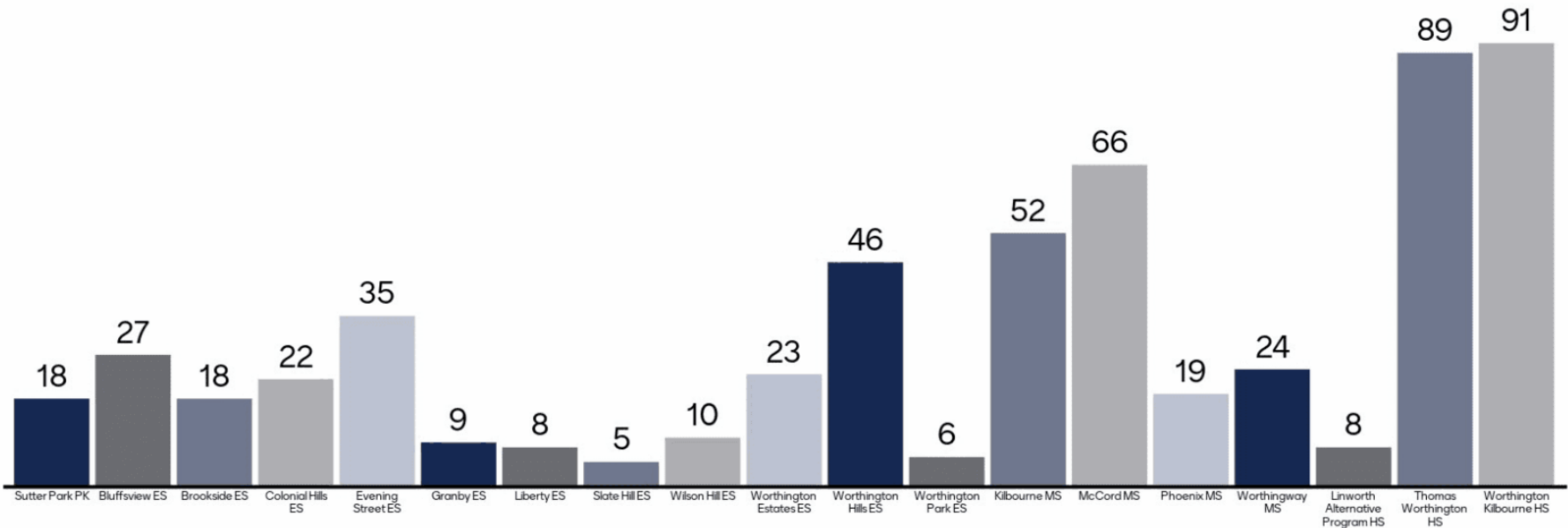
This survey was not well promoted within the district. I only learned about it last night on a Wolves, Inc. call. The district should have distributed this survey through the school email lists to ensure broad participation.
