Please rest assured that there are enough tickets for every senior to get four (4) tickets; however, timeliness will dictate the position in the arena in which your seats are situated. In past years our commencement ceremony announced graduates using two lines separated alphabetically. Although we don't have that information determined to the exact letter and student to the side in which they are sitting, we do plan to use the same system. The first half of the alphabet will likely be seated on the NORTH side (last two digits of the section numbers are above 20) of the floor and the second half on the SOUTH side (last two digits of the section numbers are below 10) of the floor. Immunization Clinic Opening Up May 10th!

The Columbus Health Department is reopening the Immunization Clinic for all **routine** or any missed **childhood vaccines**.

- Notices will be sent out to families from the school nurse who are missing vaccines. Please make arrangements to have those completed over the summer to meet State compliance.
- > 16 year olds: If your child is or will be 16 this summer please be sure they receive the Meningococcal vaccine required by the State of Ohio.
- Seniors: All seniors are required to have a meningococcal vaccine on file received on/after age 16. This requirement need to be on file in August 2021 for all 12th graders.
- Covid 19 vaccines: a walk in clinic is now available for the Covid 19 vaccine for age 16 and over. Vaccines may soon be available for 12 and up! Please check with Columbus public health for availability.

What to bring: most recent vaccination record, insurance card and copay if applicable, parent ID, custody or guardian papers.

No child under 18 years is refused for inability to pay.

Proof of all vaccines are to be turned in to the Health Office. Records can be emailed to jgarner@wscloud.org or faxed to 614-450-6560.

*** COVID-19 Information*** Revised March 22

As we finish the school year, with all students attending school daily, it is extremely important **NOT** to send your student to school if they are sick and not feeling well. A daily health check is required for parents and students to complete each morning prior to school.

<u>Daily Home COVID-19 "Before School" Screening</u>
Protocol for COVID-19 School Screening and Follow Up Requirements

If your child develops or reports any of the symptoms listed below during the school day they will be isolated and a parent or guardian will be called for immediate pick up. Follow-up with a health care provider will be required for your student to return to school. The COVID-19 protocols will be strictly enforced to ensure a healthy environment for our students and staff.

Your child needs to be kept home if any of the following symptoms are present:

- > Temperature 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher when taken by mouth
- New or worsened cough
- Loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Nasal congestion or runny nose
- Vomiting or diarrhea

Your child needs to be kept home if TWO or more of the following symptoms are present:

- Headaches
- Body aches
- > Fatigue
- ➤ Nausea

Quarantine Guidelines for a Positive Case WITHIN THE HOME:

All students within the home should quarantine, from school and activities, following a positive test of a family member. This would also apply to a symptomatic family member who is awaiting a test result.

Quarantine Guidelines for a Positive Case AT SCHOOL:

According to the Columbus Public Health department, if a student not wearing a mask is found to be within 3 feet of a person who tested positive for COVID-19 for more than 15 minutes, the student must quarantine from school and all other activities.

If a student is found to be between 3 feet and 6 feet of a person who tested positive with COVID-19 for more than 15 minutes while wearing masks, the student may attend school and they can participate in after-school activities, including sports.

Finally, if a student is found to be more than 6 feet of a person who tested positive with COVID-19, the student does not need to be quarantined. (6ft is still the standard outside of school)

Other Exemptions to the Quarantine Guidelines:

- > Students that have had a positive COVID-19 test within the past 90 days are exempt.
- > Students that have had two doses of the COVID-19 vaccine are also exempt.
