

Immunization Clinic Opening Up May 10th!

Attention WKHS/Linworth/Academy/DACC Parents and Guardians:

If your child has missed any routine vaccinations this year due to the pandemic or any other reason please see the following for general vaccine clinic information to get them back on schedule. This clinic is able to administer the Meningococcal (serogroup A,C,W,Y) vaccine that is required for all 12th graders in August 2021.

*** COVID-19 Information*** Revised March 22

As we finish the school year, with all students attending school daily, it is extremely important **NOT** to send your student to school if they are sick and not feeling well. A daily health check is required for parents and students to complete each morning prior to school.

<u>Daily Home COVID-19 "Before School" Screening</u>
Protocol for COVID-19 School Screening and Follow Up Requirements

If your child develops or reports any of the symptoms listed below during the school day they will be isolated and a parent or guardian will be called for immediate pick up. Follow-up with a health care provider will be required for your student to return to school. The COVID-19 protocols will be strictly enforced to ensure a healthy environment for our students and staff.

Your child needs to be kept home if any of the following symptoms are present:

- > Temperature 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher when taken by mouth
- New or worsened cough
- Loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Nasal congestion or runny nose
- Vomiting or diarrhea

Your child needs to be kept home if TWO or more of the following symptoms are present:

- Headaches
- Body aches
- Fatigue
- Nausea

Quarantine Guidelines for a Positive Case WITHIN THE HOME:

All students within the home should quarantine, from school and activities, following a positive test of a family member. This would also apply to a symptomatic family member who is awaiting a test result.

Quarantine Guidelines for a Positive Case AT SCHOOL:

According to the Columbus Public Health department, if a student not wearing a mask is found to be within 3 feet of a person who tested positive for COVID-19 for more than 15 minutes, the student must quarantine from school and all other activities.

If a student is found to be between 3 feet and 6 feet of a person who tested positive with COVID-19 for more than 15 minutes while wearing masks, the student may attend school and they can participate in after-school activities, including sports.

Finally, if a student is found to be more than 6 feet of a person who tested positive with COVID-19, the student does not need to be quarantined. (6ft is still the standard outside of school)

Other Exemptions to the Quarantine Guidelines:

- > Students that have had a positive COVID-19 test within the past 90 days are exempt.
- > Students that have had two doses of the COVID-19 vaccine are also exempt.
