Reminder: The Ohio Department of Health requires all 7<sup>th</sup> graders to have a Tdap vaccine and a Meningitis vaccine prior to the start of school. Children will not be permitted to start 7<sup>th</sup> grade without proper proof of immunization. It is advisable to make an appointment for your child to receive these vaccines to avoid exclusion. As soon as your child receives this vaccine, please provide proof of immunization from your physician to your school office so that we can update your child's school health record

Although the following immunizations are not "required" by law, they are also recommended for children of this age group. Please check with your physician about the benefits of receiving the following recommended immunizations:

- Hep A: protection against Hepatitis A
- HPV to protect against virus known to cause cervical cancer
- Influenza and H1N1: protection against common flu
