About Me tab



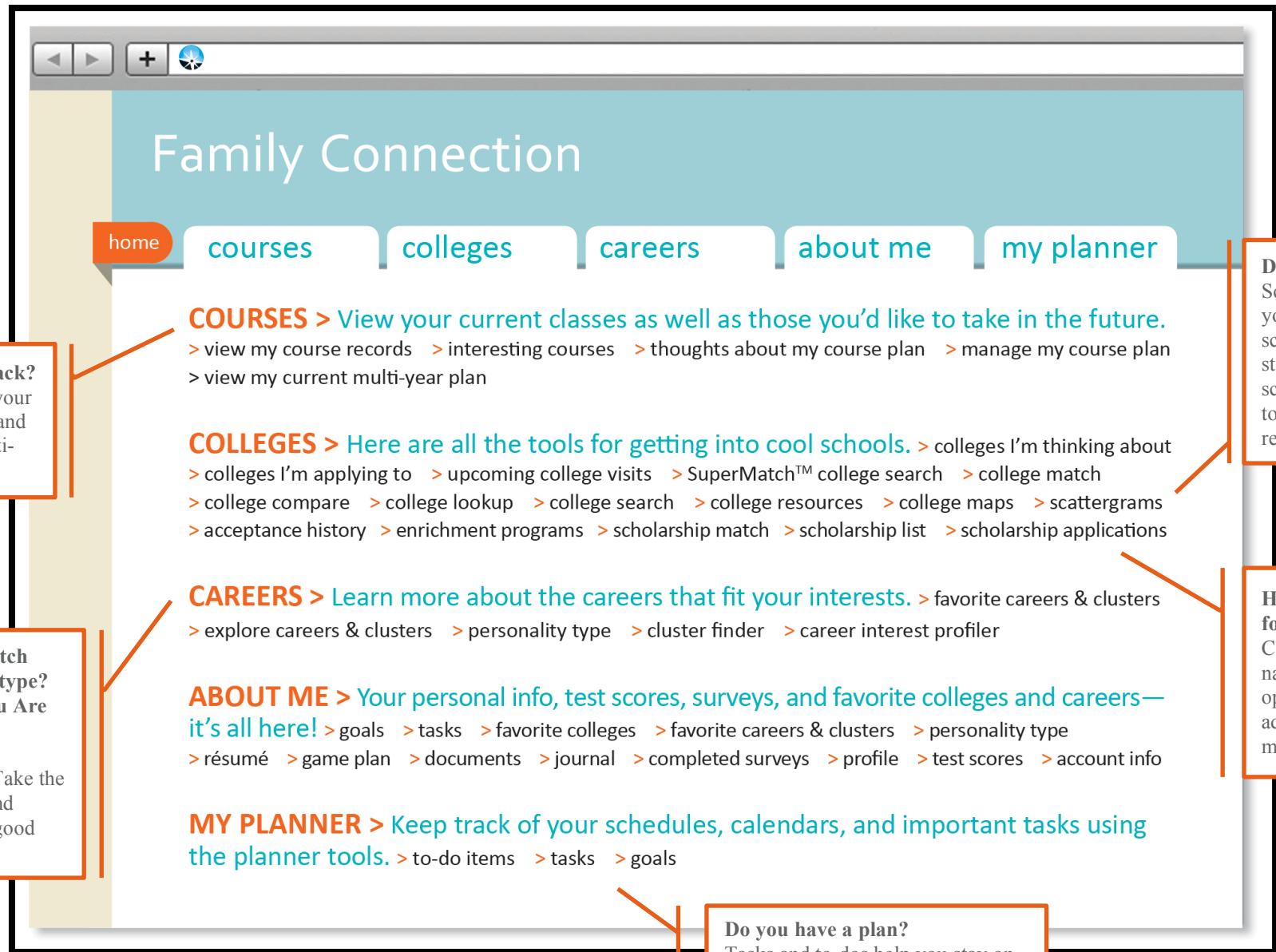
- Set academic and personal goals
